Department: Physical Education Course/Grade Level: Kindergarten

Unit Title: Group Activities Number of Lessons/Days: 11 lessons / Trimester 3

**Unit Summary:** In this unit, students will combine skills learned in trimester 1 and 2 for group activities. Students will learn about teamwork and interacting with others during physical education activities. Students will learn to resolve conflict appropriately. Students will demonstrate how to make responsible and safe choices and improve on task behavior.
