This week we will...

- Practice identifying shapes by name and begin learning about the parts of shapes that make them unique (e.g., a rectangle has 4 sides - 2 short sides and 2 long sides) during small group
- Continue talking about anger and ways to appropriately express this emotion
- Use the question of the day to focus on identifying each letter in our names

Try it at Home:

- Help your child to recognize their name by sight as well as to identify and name each letter in it.
- Have your child "read" their library book to you! Encourage them to tell what is happening on each page by closely looking at the pictures to tell their own story.
- Continue working with your child on zipping their jacket independently.
- Encourage your child to try new things, even if they are difficult - remind them that it is okay to not be able to do something the first time they try.
