Try it at Home:

- Find the math hidden in your every day life how many steps from the car to our house/apartment? Who has more _____ (insert food here) on their plate? If we first put away three toys, and then put away two more, how many toys did we put away in all? --- Doing math with your preschooler does not need to be formal or complex, simply look at the things you already do, and find opportunities to count, find numerals or shapes, compare size or number of items, sort things into groups etc.
- Practice identifying the feelings of characters in books you read with your child, asking, 'How do you think _____ is feeling?' 'How do you know?'
- o Help your child identify each letter in his/her first name.
