- o Making choices for play time activities
- Waiting our turn
- o Practicing classroom rules, routines & expectations
- o Beginning CIA testing, starting Monday, September 23

Try it at Home:

- Have your child get ready for the day independently allow extra time so that you (and your child) do not feel frustrated or rushed
- Help your child practice sitting on the floor "crisscross applesauce" hands in their laps; this will help them to stay within the confines of their own square during our carpet time.
- Go on a shape, color, number or letter hunt can you find them on a cereal box? A street sign? A nature walk?
- Read to your child, and allow them to read to you (we are learning to "read the pictures" and tell our own stories when reading independently)
