Your student will receive Blaine High School registration materials on January 10th (NMS) or January 11th (RMS), 2019. At that time, counselors will guide your student through the entire course selection/registration process. Your student is encouraged to talk to his or her current teachers and ask for their advice about appropriate course selections for next year. Students should bring the materials home for you to review. **Student registration should be completed online from home by following the detailed instructions given to your student or found on the Blaine High School website www.ahschools/bhs. Students can register online beginning on January 10th, and the deadline is 11:59 PM on Friday, January 18th.**

If your student is currently attending a private school or is home schooled, you may pick up enrollment paperwork and registration materials from the BHS Counseling Office any time after January 11th. The Counseling Office is open from 7:10AM–3:30PM M-F. Please turn in registration course requests with your enrollment paperwork by January 18th. Your student will not register online.

We will be hosting a **Registration Information Evening at Blaine High School on Tuesday, January 15th from 6:30-8:00 PM** in an open house format. **A computer lab will also be available for additional online support.** In addition, Jenny Birkmeier will be holding a brief informational session at **6:00 PM in the Auditorium** for parents and students accepted into the Center for Engineering, Mathematics & Science program (CEMS).

We will present helpful information in a general session in the Auditorium at 6:35 PM, answer registration questions with department representatives in the cafeteria, and give students the opportunity to enter their registration course numbers in the computer lab throughout the evening.

Please help your student choose classes that will satisfy the requirements for graduation, are at the appropriate level of difficulty, and will be of interest to him/her. Schedule changes will be made on a very limited basis only if errors have occurred. We know from experience that students are more successful when families are involved in the registration process.
