7th & 8th Graders

This year the weekly video announcements will be produced & edited by a group of 7th & 8th grade students who are selected to work on announcements during Mr Keeney's PRIDE. Students will work as journalism groups to research, produce, and edit video segments that will be part of a 5-minute news production that will be viewed every Friday morning. The goal is to provide students the opportunity to tell stories about what is happening around Oak View every week, and share that information in the form of a pre-recorded presentation for all students and staff.

This opportunity is available for all 7th & 8th grade Oak View students. Because a great amount of the work on the stories will take place on Tuesday through Thursday during PRIDE, you must maintain excellent grades in all of your classes and be able to work together with other students for both the on-air and the editing responsibilities of the news stories. The video announcement students will also need to stay after school every Thursday to do the final editing and production of the video show so that it is ready for broadcasting on Friday morning.
