Start at our website anokacountylibrary.org and search by author, title, subject, or keyword to find books, magazines, CDs, DVDs, eBooks, database articles, and more.

Got too many results? Narrow your search by choosing limiters on the left side of the page, so you end up seeing only the types of materials you need at your library.

Log in to your library account with your barcode number and PIN to see due dates, renew items, and request materials for pickup at your library.

Databases and Subject Guides

eBooks

Access downloadable eBooks and eAudiobooks wherever you have Wi-Fi! Downloadable resources like this won't ever have overdue fees, either!

Go to the App Store or Google Play store and

search for **Cloud Library**. Download and install the app. Choose **Minnesota**, **Anoka County Library**, and then enter your **library barcode number** and **PIN** when prompted.

Once you're logged in, you're ready to go! Browse by subject or genre or search by keyword to checkout and download eBooks and eAudiobooks. You can request titles that are already checked out and get an email when they're ready for checkout.


