

Break It!:

You will need a pencil and paper. Draw a tic tac toe board on paper. Fill in numbers from 6-9 in random places, repeating numbers will be necessary. Now choose the tic tac toe or bingo version of the game Break it! Have Fun.

Tic Tac Toe Version: You will need paper and 2 different color markers or pencils. Flip a coin to see who goes first. First person writes the number model ($5+4$) on the number square he/she is selecting to try to get three in a row. The second person does the same. Keep marking numbers with the equations. There is one rule, even though there is a repeat of a number, you cannot use the same number model. If you see $5+4$ and $6+3$ on the board already you must come up with a different one, such as $7+2$.

Bingo version: (4 sets of #s 6-9 as number cards or 10 frames or dominos) Pick a card, name or show 1 way to build that number using fingers, numbers or 10 frames. If correct write the number model under the number on the tic tac toe board. When you get three number models or equations written in your color in a row or fill the board before your partner, the game is over.
