Cross Out:

(2 players, 2 dice, 1 paper and a pencil)

Write the numbers 1-12 in a row across the paper. Have your partner do the same. Flip a coin or roll a die to see who goes first. First person: Roll your dice. Add the two numbers together to find the sum. Now you can choose to cross out whichever two numbers you want as long as they equal the sum you rolled, or cross out the actual sum if it isn't already crossed off. Now your partner goes, doing the same. Keep rolling and crossing out the numbers until you cant cross out any other numbers. Add up the number or numbers you didn't cross out. Whoever has the least amount left wins that round.

Variation: Be the last one to cross off the last number and you are the winner.
