Number Hunt:

Use the number cards that range up to 120. Pull out 10 cards from one decade (ex. Just the 40s) or 10 that cross a decade (5 cards from 40s and 5 cards from 50s. Lay the cards face down mixed up in 1 row. Pick one card up, put a penny to keep the place of that card. Then Count BW from right to left to find where the card should be placed. Ex. If the 40s family start at 49 and count back until you find where your card goes. Pick up that face down card and put your card face up in its place. Now do the same for the card you just picked up. Keep going until all cards are placed in order. Now the fun part. Keep them in order but flip them over. Have mom or dad turn one card over at a time moving backward (or forward if that is what you are working on) with you trying to name the card before they turn it over. If you name them all before they get them turned over, you win. If not, try again to practice. You can play the same game counting forward too.
