Woods 2

Course Description:

This course is designed to give the students skills and knowledge of woodworking. Students will develop skills through hands on experiences. An understanding of operations, equipment, and techniques used in woodworking will be learned through lectures, demonstrations, and hands on experiences.

Course Content:

The course will cover the following areas: Safety, equipment, materials, and techniques used in woodworking. The student will complete 1 project which will require use of many different machines in the shop.

Course Outcomes:

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Upon completion students will be able to safely perform multiple operations using various pieces of equipment in the shop.

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Upon completion students will be able to demonstrate an understanding of various finishes for wood projects by finishing their projects.

Upon completion students will be able to follow a set of plans to make a project.

Materials Needed For Class:

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The basic project is the nightstand made out of particle board. The paint for the particle board will need to be purchased on their own. If students choose to upgrade the night stand to oak, Birch, Cherry or Walnut they need to purchase shop cards before they start making the project. The cost of the upgrades will be discussed at the beginning of the term in class. You can contact the instructor at the beginning of the term as well for the costs of the upgrades. If students choose to make the TV / VCR cabinet it is an additional upgrade in shop cards over the nightstand, oak only. Students will be starting the project at the beginning of the second week of the term. Shop cards can be purchased in the financial office which is located in the main office before school or after school. Students will not be allowed to get the cards during class.

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Students will need to purchase on their own the hinges and handles for the cabinet. These will be needed by week 9. The types of hinges that will work will be discussed in class close to the time that they will be needed.

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It is recommended for the students to have their own tape measure. Students that have their own tape measure often have their project turn out better and complete it sooner.
